

AMERICAN HINDU COALITION WINS IN US SUPREME COURT RULING BANNING USE OF RACE AS A CRITERIA IN COLLEGE ADMISSION



WASHINGTON, DC – June 29, 2023. Today, the American Hindu Coalition (AHC), a coalition partner of Students for Fair Admission (SFFA) [Plaintiff], celebrates victory with the Supreme Court ruling against Harvard and University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill [Defendants].

This landmark ruling ends use of race as a factor in college admission, pointing to an ill-defined identification of black or Hispanic students and race rather than merit as determinative of

admission offers (i.e., standardized test scores, grades, or extracurricular activities). Indeed, Asian Americans students, of whom a growing majority are Hindu Americans, were denied admission because of their race at a rate of 4 to 10 times higher than their black or Hispanic counterparts, despite the merit of their application. *Text of US Supreme Court's landmark decision:* 20-1199 Students for Fair Admissions, Inc. v.
